NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1) of section 35 of the Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Act, 1979 (Central Act 30 of 1979), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following amendments to the Telangana Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 1982:-

AMENDMENTS

1. In the said rules,-

- (i) in rule 3, for sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“(2) The application shall be accompanied by the Registration fees”

2. In rule 4, in sub-rule (1), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

“Provided that if no adverse order is passed by the Registering Officer within thirty days from the date of submission of the application then the registration shall be deemed to be duly granted”.

3. In rule 9, after sub-rule (2), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

“Provided that if no adverse order is passed by the Licensing Officer within thirty days from the date of submission of the application then the licence shall be deemed to be duly granted”.

4. In rule 14, after sub-rule (2), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

“Provided that if no adverse order is passed by the Licensing Officer within thirty days from the date of submission of the application then the licence shall be deemed to have been renewed”.

5. In rule 19, after sub-rule (1), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

“Provided that the payment may be made by alternate mechanism as ordered by the Government”.
