ORDER :-

Whereas, by Section 101 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 (Central Act No. 6 of 2014), the appropriate Government i.e. the State of Telangana is empowered by order, to make such adaptations, and modifications of any law (as defined in Section 2(f) of the Act) made before 02.06.2014, whether by way of repeal or amendment as may be necessary or expedient for the purpose of facilitating the application of such law in the State of Telangana before expiration of two years from 02.06.2014; and there upon every such law shall have effect subject to the adaptations and modifications so made until altered, repealed or amended by a competent legislature or other competent authority;

2. And whereas, the Andhra Pradesh Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 was in force as on 1.6.2014;

3. And whereas, after careful examination, Government have decided to adapt the Andhra Pradesh Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 as amended from time to time with necessary modification, so as to facilitate its application to the State of Telangana.

4. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in an Extraordinary Issue of the Telangana Gazette, dated: 06.02.2016.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 101 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 (Central Act No.6 of 2014), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following order, namely:-

1. (1) This order may be called The Andhra Pradesh Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 – (Telangana adaptation) Order, 2014.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force w.e.f. 02.06.2014.

2. In this Order, the “law” i.e. The Andhra Pradesh Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 being adapted in this order shall have the same meaning as defined in section 2 (f) of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 (Central Act No. 6 of 2014).

3. The Andhra Pradesh General Clauses Act, 1891 applies for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of a State Act.

4. For the purpose of this Order, and the Act, Rules adapted herein the expression “the State” shall have the meaning and area as specified in section 3 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014.

5. As from the appointment day, the Andhra Pradesh Rules mentioned in the Schedule to this order, shall until altered, repealed or amended by a competent legislature or other competent authority, have effect subject to the options and modifications directed by that Schedule.
6. In the Andhra Pradesh Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 :
- (1) throughout the Act, for the words “Andhra Pradesh” (occurring otherwise than in a citation or description or title of other laws including the Rules as the case may be), the word “Telangana” shall be substituted.
- (2) in section 1, in sub-section (4), in clause (i) after the words “to all areas” the words “in Telangana” shall be inserted.
- (3) in section-3, after sub-section (2), the following proviso shall be added, namely:-
- “Provided that if no adverse order is passed by the Inspector within thirty days from the date of submission of the statement under sub-section (1), then the registration shall be deemed to be duly granted.”
- (4) in section-4, after sub-section (3) the following proviso shall added, namely:-
- “Provided that if no adverse order is passed by the Inspector within thirty days from the date of submission of the application then the registration certificate shall be deemed to have been renewed.”
- (5) in section-68, after sub-section (1), the following proviso shall be added, namely:-
- “Provided that the Government, by order may devise or notify consolidated forms for maintaining registers and records and furnishing reports and returns in lieu of the forms prescribed under the Act or Rules made thereunder:
- Provided further that the Government may allow the registers and records to be maintained in computerized or digital formats.”
- (6) in section 31, for the words 1st November (Andhra Pradesh Formation Day), the words 2nd June, (Telangana Formation Day) shall be substituted.
